5. In verse 5 Paul exhorts his readers to "have the same attitude that Jesus Christ had." Based on the context of Paul's words (in 1-8), what attitude did Jesus have that we should have?

6. How could you be more like Jesus in your attitude this week? Ask the group to pray for your next step.


2. Jesus _____ Us
